



Call for Student Video Submissions on Smart Grid Communications

The IEEE SmartGridComm 2017 (SGC2017) Committee is pleased to invite your participation in the 8th IEEE International Conference on Smart Grid Communications. The conference will be held in Dresden, Germany on **23–26 October 2017**. It seeks to bring together researchers and practitioners from academia, industry and governmental institutions from around the world who are leveraging and developing Information and Communication technologies for the Intelligent Grid with emphasis on the economic, environmental, and societal benefits.

Prospective research students are invited to submit entries for the SGC2017 Video Competition on any aspect of IEEE SmartGridComm as outlined at <http://sgc2017.ieee-smartgridcomm.org/student-competition>.

A € 500.00 award will be presented to the winner(s) of the winning video.

SELECTION PROCESS

- Approval of video. Videos will be screened by a jury for compliance with the scope of the competition as outlined above.
- Approved videos. The approved videos will be posted on the IEEE SmartGridComm website, where visitors will be able to vote.
- Top 3 videos. The top 3 voted videos will be selected.

Note that only students are eligible to participate.

AWARDS

The winning video will be decided by the selection committee, from the 3 top voted videos and will be announced on the conference website on the date specified.
